#### What to include

You must include the following information on your selected city:

Possible locations for lodging including a picture of the hotel/resort, the address, phone number, accommodations, and room rates. (At least 5 should be included)

Flight information: include possible airlines and estimated plane ticket prices roundtrip.


International Traveling Tips: i.e. passport information, safety, money suggestions, etc.

Attractive Restaurants including famous dishes with description and price. (At least 5 should be included)

**A conversion chart** from American Dollars to Dominican Pesos with the current exchange rate. Also include pictures of different forms of pesos in bills and coins.

Biography of the President of the country and a description of the government.

**Daytime and Night time attractions** (i.e. museums, parks, nightclubs, shopping venues etc.) [At least 5 should be included)




# Grading Rubric
