**Postdoc Guidelines**

**Description:**

One-year teaching postdoc with a 2-2 teaching load. Competitive salary and professional development funds.

**Eligibility:**

Candidates must plan to defend their dissertations by August 1.

Applicants must have applied for other kinds of fellowship and should detail that in their application essay.

They must have applied for academic jobs and should detail that in their application.

The candidate must be a graduate student in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese and must have an official mentor in the department.

**Requirements:**

CV

Three letters of recommendation; one must be from the advisor and one from a course coordinator in the Department of Spanish and Portuguese.

If the applicant has not completed the dissertation, advisor must specifically speak to the likelihood of doing so by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

An application statement (or cover letter, 1 page), which summarizes the research and teaching goals for the postdoc, identifies the preferred mentor, and identifies career goals.

Teaching and Research Statements.

Teaching evaluations from the most recent years of teaching.

**Selection Process:**

Candidate must send application file to the Chair of the Postdoc committee by the first Monday after Spring Break.

**Note:**

The Department of Spanish and Portuguese nominates the candidate for the post doc and sends the nomination to the College of Arts and Science. The final decision regarding the offer rests with the College of Arts and Science, as do the specific terms of the offer.
