Your enrollment window will open at 8 a.m. on the Monday of your appointment week and close at 11:59 p.m. on the Friday of that week. Note that Nashville is in the Central Time Zone and all assigned windows are in Central Time.

Your adviser will contact you the week prior to, or the week of, your registration window with important information on class selection. You will also have an opportunity to participate in online group information sessions.

Please make sure to check your Vanderbilt email account often, as email is the primary and official way that we will communicate with you. The University Registrar's Office has sent a message regarding AccessVU to the email address listed in your application. If you have not already done so, please follow the instructions in that message to activate your VUNetID and Vanderbilt email account.

If you completed any college courses while you were in high school, you *may* be eligible to earn pre-freshman credit. Please visit as.vanderbilt.edu/students/student-resources.php for the Application for Pre-Freshman Credit. Submit any necessary materials as soon as possible; pre-freshman credit must be resolved before classes begin in the fall.

If you have taken, or will take, Advanced Placement exams, request that the College Board send your scores to Vanderbilt. Enrollment in certain courses with pre-requisites will be subject to review in early August, and your AP credits may be used to satisfy those requirements. Students who do not meet necessary pre-requisites in August may be dropped from the class(es) for which the pre-requisite has not been met.

Again, welcome. We look forward to seeing you on the Vanderbilt campus in August.
